SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Finance and Procurement

Each

- (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, EACH contractor and subcontractor under a public work contract shall pay not less than the prevailing wage rate of:
 - (1) straight time to an employee who works:
- (I) [8] 10 hours or less in a single calendar day except a Sunday or legal-holiday; and \overline{OR}
 - (H) 40 HOURS OR LESS DURING 1 WORKWEEK; AND
 - (2) overtime to an employee for each hour the employee works:
 - (i) in excess of [8] 10 hours in any single calendar day; [and]
 - (II) IN EXCESS OF 40 HOURS DURING 1-WORKWEEK; AND OR

[(ii)](III) on a Sunday or legal heliday. <u>STRAIGHT TIME TO AN</u> EMPLOYEE FOR EACH HOUR THAT THE EMPLOYEE WORKS.

- (B) A CONTRACTOR AND SUBCONTRACTOR SHALL PAY AN EMPLOYEE THE PREVAILING WAGE RATE OF OVERTIME FOR EACH HOUR THAT THE EMPLOYEE WORKS:
 - (1) IN EXCESS OF 10 HOURS IN ANY SINGLE CALENDAR DAY;
 - (2) IN EXCESS OF 40 HOURS PER EACH WORKWEEK; OR
 - (3) ON SUNDAY OR A LEGAL HOLIDAY.

- (a) Each contractor under a public work contract subject to this subtitle shall:
- (1) post a clearly legible statement of each prevailing wage rate to be paid under the public work contract; and
