

(6) The county may appeal a decision of the Circuit Court under this section to the Court of Special Appeals.

[E.] F. If the County Commissioners condemn any necessary land for the use of roads, the procedures [outlines] OUTLINED in [the Annotated Code,] TITLE 12 OF THE Real Property Article[, Title 12] OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, ARTICLE 23, § 339 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, and applicable sections of [Article 89B] TITLE 8 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND are to be followed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1997.

**CHAPTER 691**

**(House Bill 751)**

AN ACT concerning

**Health Occupations – Dental Hygienists**

FOR the purpose of altering the education requirements for an applicant for a license to practice dental hygiene; altering the information that an applicant for a license to practice dental hygiene must submit to the Board of Dental Examiners (Board); altering the education requirements for applicants who fail a certain examination a certain number of times; altering the required qualifications for an applicant for a temporary license to practice dental hygiene; authorizing the Board to maintain an action to enjoin the unauthorized practice of dental hygiene; and generally relating to dental hygienists.
