

[(i)] (1) A Class H beer (on-sale) license; or

[(ii)](2) A Class H beer and light wine (on-sale) license.

[(2) (i)] (B) (1) As a condition to holding any license under this [subsection] SECTION, the Director or Deputy Director shall designate an individual with respect to each golf course to complete training in an alcohol awareness program approved under § 13-101 of this article.

[(ii)](2) The individual designated by the Director or Deputy Director shall:

[1.] (I) Represent the concessionaire; and

[2.] (II) Be involved with the management of the sale of beer or light wine by the concessionaire at the golf course.

~~SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the intent of this Act is to revise, without substantive change, the provisions of § 9-102(a-2) and (a-3) of Article 2B and the provisions of this Act do not in any manner affect any license or licenses issued pursuant to the provisions of § 9-102(a-2) or (a-3) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland.~~

SECTION 4. 3 AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.
