- (b) Any person who knowingly gives any false information or makes any material misstatement in an application to purchase a regulated firearm or an application for a regulated firearms [dealers] DEALER'S license shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction be fined not more than \$5,000 or imprisoned for not more than 3 years, or both.
