

**CHAPTER 728**

**(House Bill 1222)**

AN ACT concerning

**Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages  
(Golf Course ~~License~~ *License – II*)**

FOR the purpose of creating a Class GC (golf course) beer, wine and liquor alcoholic beverages license for issuance to ~~golf courses a person that owns a certain owners or operators of golf course courses~~ in Harford County ~~that meets certain requirements~~; providing for the specifications for the license; exempting the license from certain restrictions; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Harford County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 8-501 through 8-503, respectively, of Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 8-502 through 8-504, respectively.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

8-501.

- (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN HARFORD COUNTY.
- (B) THERE IS A CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
