- (a) If an applicant qualifies for a license under this subtitle, the Board shall send the applicant a notice that states that:
 - (1) the applicant has qualified for a license; and
- (2) the Board will issue a license to the applicant, on receipt of a license fee of:
 - (i) [\$150] \$60 for a license to practice land surveying; and
 - (ii) \$20 for a license to practice property line surveying.
- (b) On payment of the appropriate license fee, the Board shall issue a license to each applicant who meets the requirements of this subtitle.
 - (c) The Board shall include on each license that the Board issues:
 - (1) the full name of the licensee;
 - (2) the registration number assigned by the Board to the licensee; and
- (3) the signatures of the chairman and secretary of the Board, under seal of the Board.
- (d) Subject to any regulation that the Board adopts, it shall replace any lost, mutilated, or destroyed license certificate on:
 - (1) request of the licensee; and
- (2) payment of the replacement fee set by the Board, not exceeding \$35. 15-314.
- (a) Unless a license is renewed for a 2-year term as provided in this section, the license expires on the first June 30 that comes:
 - (1) after the effective date of the license; and
 - (2) in an odd-numbered year.
- (b) (1) At least 1 month before a license expires, the Board shall mail to the licensee, at the last known address of the licensee:
 - (i) a renewal application form; and
 - (ii) a notice that states:
 - 1. the date on which the current license expires;
- 2. the date by which the Board must receive the renewal application for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and
 - 3. the amount of the renewal fee.
