(a) The Secretary shall appoint a State registrar of vital records, who shall be in the [classified] SKILLED service of the State Personnel Management System.

(d) In addition to any other power or duty that the Director or Secretary delegates, the administrative head of a State facility shall:

(2) In accordance with the provisions of the State Personnel and Pensions Article [that govern classified service employees], appoint a staff for the State facility as needed and as provided in the State budget; and

(c) (1) The Superintendent of the Center and each individual in a scientific position or technical position shall be in the [unclassified service of] MANAGEMENT SERVICE OR SPECIAL APPOINTMENTS IN the State Personnel Management System.

(d) (2) Staff hired after September 30, 1992, are in the [unclassified service of] EXECUTIVE SERVICE, MANAGEMENT SERVICE, OR ARE SPECIAL APPOINTMENTS IN the State Personnel Management System.

(d) The Commissioner is in the [unclassified] EXECUTIVE service of the State Personnel Management System and is entitled to compensation under the Executive Pay Plan in accordance with the State budget.

(a) (2) The Deputy Commissioner is in the [unclassified] EXECUTIVE service of the State Personnel Management System and is entitled to compensation in accordance with the State budget.

(b) All employees of the Administration that serve in a management, professional, or technical capacity are in the [unclassified service of] EXECUTIVE SERVICE,
