SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 314.

This bill requires that a sunset evaluation of the Health Care Access and Cost Commission and regulations related to the Commission be made on or before July 1, 2002.

House Bill 428, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on April 29, 1997, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 314.
