Senate Bill No. 345

AN ACT concerning

**Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages
(Tasting Licenses Days)**

FOR the purpose of altering the ~~amount of time during which an alcoholic beverages licensee in Harford County may conduct tasting events~~ number of days during which the Harford County Liquor Control Board may issue tasting or sampling licenses; altering a fee, specifying the use of that time; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Harford County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages
Section 8-407(c) and (f)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1996 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

8-407.

(c) Each of the respective tasting or sampling licenses under this ~~subsection~~ SECTION is effective for a maximum of [24] 52 days in any licensing period, ~~WITH NO MORE THAN 1 DAY IN ANY WEEK.~~

(f) The cost of the CWBT license for holders of a BWL license is [\$250] \$350 each year in addition to the cost of the BWL license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.
