(F) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES <u>SUBSECTIONS</u> <u>SUBSECTION</u> (B) OR (C) OF THIS SECTION <u>SHALL</u> <u>MAY BE REQUIRED TO</u> MAKE FULL RESTITUTION OF THE MONEY; GOODS, <u>SERVICES</u>, OR THE VALUE OF THE GOODS OR <u>SERVICES</u> <u>HEALTH CARE</u> SERVICES OR OTHER GOODS OR <u>SERVICES</u> UNLAWFULLY RECEIVED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 683.

This bill amends the Franciscan Center Loan of 1994 by changing the address of the project for which the bond proceeds will be used from 2214 Maryland Avenue in Baltimore to 101 West 23rd Street in Baltimore and it extends, from June 1, 1997 to June 1, 1998, the time by which the Franciscan Center must provide evidence of matching funds.

House Bill 280, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on April 29, 1997, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 683.
