

- (IV) AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-BASIC;
- (V) AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC; OR
- (VI) A FIRST RESPONDER.

(7) "EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-AMBULANCE" (EMT-A) MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS:

(I) COMPLETED AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-AMBULANCE COURSE APPROVED BY THE EMS BOARD;

(II) DEMONSTRATED COMPETENCE IN MEDICAL PROTOCOLS AS DETERMINED BY THE EMS BOARD; AND

(III) BEEN EXAMINED BY THE EMS BOARD AND CERTIFIED AS AN EMT-A BY THE EMS BOARD.

(8) "EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-BASIC" (EMT-B) MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS:

(I) COMPLETED AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-BASIC COURSE APPROVED BY THE EMS BOARD;

(II) DEMONSTRATED COMPETENCE IN MEDICAL PROTOCOLS AS DETERMINED BY THE EMS BOARD; AND

(III) BEEN EXAMINED BY THE EMS BOARD AND CERTIFIED AS AN EMT-B BY THE EMS BOARD.

(9) "EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC" (EMT-P) MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS:

(I) COMPLETED AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC COURSE APPROVED BY THE EMS BOARD;

(II) BEEN TESTED AND REGISTERED BY THE NATIONAL REGISTRY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS, INC. AS AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC;

(III) DEMONSTRATED COMPETENCE IN MEDICAL PROTOCOLS WITHIN THIS STATE AS DETERMINED BY THE EMS BOARD; AND

(IV) BEEN LICENSED AS AN EMT-P BY THE EMS BOARD.

(10) "FIRST RESPONDER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS:

(I) COMPLETED A FIRST RESPONDER COURSE APPROVED BY THE EMS BOARD; AND

(II) BEEN EXAMINED BY THE EMS BOARD AND CERTIFIED AS A FIRST RESPONDER BY THE EMS BOARD.
