**House Bill No. 698**

AN ACT concerning

**Blind, Deaf, or Mobility Impaired Pedestrians – Right-of-Way – Penalties**

FOR the purpose of altering the number of points that the Motor Vehicle Administration is required to assess against an individual convicted of certain motor vehicle violations related to the failure to yield the right-of-way to blind, deaf, or mobility impaired pedestrians; and generally relating to the penalties for motor vehicle violations.
