This bill increases the one-day license fee for a special Class C beer or beer and wine license in Carroll County from \$10 to \$50.

Senate Bill 553, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on this date, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 1047.
