 - (a) The Commission may adopt:
 - (1) reasonable bylaws for the conduct of its proceedings;
 - (2) reasonable regulations for the conduct of hearings;
 - (3) reasonable regulations to govern applications for licenses; and
- (4) subject to subsection (c) of this section, reasonable regulations to carry out this title.
- (b) [(1)] The Commission shall adopt guidelines that establish a schedule for the prompt and timely processing and resolution of each complaint made to the Commission.
- [(2) On or before October 1 of each year, the Commission shall report to the General Assembly on the number of cases resolved within the schedule adopted under paragraph (1) of this subsection.]
