(b) (1) A licensee may employ any person between the ages of 18 and 21 years for the general purposes of employment.

(2) A person BETWEEN AGES 18 AND 21 YEARS may [not] sell or serve [alcoholic beverages except] beer and light wine.

(3) In order to be permitted to sell or serve [alcoholic beverages other than beer and light wine] DISTILLED SPIRITS, a person shall be 21 years of age or older.

(a) [In] THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN Dorchester County[, no manufacturer or wholesaler shall sell any beer to any retail dealer except for cash on delivery. [12-211.

In Frederick County no manufacturer or wholesaler shall sell any beer to any retail dealer except for cash on delivery. No suit or action ex contractu to enforce or collect any claim for credit extended in violation of this section shall be maintained in this State.] RESERVED.

12-212.

[(c) In Garrett County a manufacturer or wholesaler may not sell any beer to any retail dealer except for cash on delivery. A suit or action ex contractu to enforce or collect any claim for credit extended in violation of this section may not be maintained in this State.] RESERVED.
