A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Salisbury to amend the Charter of the City of Salisbury by amending Article XVI, Purchases and Sales/City Property Inventory, § SC16-4, Procedure for competitive bidding.

CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION NO. 1996-1

A RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Sykesville to amend the Charter of the Town of Sykesville (Section 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Carroll County, 1976 Edition, as amended), by repealing and re-enacting with amendments, Section 18-52, entitled "When taxes overdue.", to bring said Section into compliance with recently enacted State law to allow certain ad valorem taxes to be paid in semi-annual installments.
