AN EMERGENCY ACT to:

- (1) create a Division of Animal Control and Humane Treatment [[under the general direction of the Chief of Police] in the Department of Police;
- (2) assign the duties and functions of the Department Of Animal Control and Humane Treatment to the Division of Animal Control and Humane Treatment.
 - (3) abolish the Department of Animal Control and Humane Treatment;
- (4) repeal provisions of the law providing for an appointed head of Animal Control and Humane Treatment; [[and]]
- (5) provide that the head of the Division of Animal Control and Humane Treatment is a non-merit position under the immediate direction of the Chief of Police; and
 - (6) generally make certain technical and stylistic changes.
