- (III) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEES ARE:
 - 1. ONE TO FIVE BEDROOMS: \$25;
 - 2. SIX TO TEN BEDROOMS: \$50; AND
 - ELEVEN OR MORE BEDROOMS: \$75.
- (IV) THE BOARD SHALL CHARGE AN ISSUING FEE IN AN AMOUNT EOUAL TO THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE.
 - (V) A CLASS B-B&B LICENSE IS AN ON-SALE ONLY LICENSE.
- (VI) THE DAYS AND HOURS OF SALE UNDER THIS LICENSE SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 11–512(B)(1) OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (VI) (VII) AN APPLICANT SHALL MEET ALL OTHER QUALIFICATIONS TO HOLD A LICENSE WITHIN THE COUNTY. THE BOARD MAY ADOPT ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS CONSISTENT WITH THIS PARAGRAPH.
- (VII) (VIII) IF THE ESTABLISHMENT CEASES TO BE OPERATED AS A BED AND BREAKFAST, THE LICENSE IS VOID.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages (Stadium Franchise Business Entity)

FOR the purpose of including an additional business entity in Frederick County to those authorizing the Frederick County Board of License Commissioners to issue a certain alcoholic beverages license to the owner of a professional baseball team franchises which may hold a stadium beer on sale alcoholic beverages license franchise that is a limited liability company; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Frederick County.
