## 1997 LAWS OF MARYLAND

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

8-211.1.

(a) The Frederick County Board of License Commissioners may issue a stadium beer on-sale license to the owner of any professional baseball team franchise, whether the franchise is a partnership, [or] corporation, OR LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.
