(Senate Bill 577)

AN ACT concerning

**Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages
(Class A Beer and Class A Beer and Wine Permits)**

FOR the purpose of creating in Frederick County a special Sunday Class A beer and a Class A beer and wine opening permit; providing for the annual fee for the special permit; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Frederick County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
