- (III) JEFFERSON VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY; AND
- (IV) MYERSVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY; AND
- (V) 4-H CAMP CENTER.
- (3) ALL NET PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR THE ENTITIES LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED SOLELY FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
- (I) IF A FIRE COMPANY, TO PURCHASE FIRE AND RESCUE EQUIPMENT, AND FOR OPERATING EXPENSES, AND FOR CONSTRUCTING AND MAINTAINING THE BUILDINGS WHICH HOUSE THE EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT; OR
- (II) IF ANOTHER ENTITY, TO CONSTRUCT, RENOVATE, AND MODERNIZE THE STRUCTURES, AND TO SUBSIDIZE THE WORK OF THE ORGANIZATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.

(e) (1) A Class A wine licensee may sell wine on Sundays.
