2-213. FEES FOR ADMINISTERING PUBLIC MONEY.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE CLERK OF A CIRCUIT COURT IS ENTITLED TO 5% OF ALL PUBLIC MONEY THAT THE CLERK RECEIVES, COLLECTS, AND PAYS OVER.

(B) ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.

THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE:

(1) 3% OF THE AMOUNT COLLECTED FOR THE TAX APPLICABLE TO INSTRUMENTS RECORDED WITH THE CLERK UNDER TITLE 12 OF THE TAX - PROPERTY ARTICLE; AND

(2) 5% OF ALL OTHER PUBLIC MONEY THAT THE CLERK RECEIVES, COLLECTS, AND PAYS OVER.

(C) BALTIMORE CITY.

THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR BALTIMORE CITY IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE:

(1) 2.5% OF THE AMOUNT COLLECTED FROM THE TAX APPLICABLE TO INSTRUMENTS RECORDED WITH THE CLERK UNDER TITLE 12 OF THE TAX - PROPERTY ARTICLE; AND

(2) 5% OF ALL OTHER PUBLIC MONEY THAT THE CLERK RECEIVES, COLLECTS, AND PAYS OVER.

(D) BALTIMORE COUNTY.

THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR BALTIMORE COUNTY IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE:

(1) 3% OF THE AMOUNT COLLECTED FROM THE TAX APPLICABLE TO INSTRUMENTS RECORDED WITH THE CLERK UNDER TITLE 12 OF THE TAX - PROPERTY ARTICLE; AND

(2) 5% OF ALL OTHER PUBLIC MONEY THAT THE CLERK RECEIVES, COLLECTS, AND PAYS OVER.

(E) CHARLES COUNTY.

(1) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR CHARLES COUNTY SHALL:
