## 2-213. FEES FOR ADMINISTERING PUBLIC MONEY.

## (A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE CLERK OF A CIRCUIT COURT IS ENTITLED TO 5% OF ALL PUBLIC MONEY THAT THE CLERK RECEIVES, COLLECTS, AND PAYS OVER.

(B) ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.

THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE:

- (1) 3% OF THE AMOUNT COLLECTED FOR THE TAX APPLICABLE TO INSTRUMENTS RECORDED WITH THE CLERK UNDER TITLE 12 OF THE TAX PROPERTY ARTICLE: AND
- (2) 5% OF ALL OTHER PUBLIC MONEY THAT THE CLERK RECEIVES, COLLECTS, AND PAYS OVER.
  - (C) BALTIMORE CITY.

THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR BALTIMORE CITY IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE:

- (1) 2.5% OF THE AMOUNT COLLECTED FROM THE TAX APPLICABLE TO INSTRUMENTS RECORDED WITH THE CLERK UNDER TITLE 12 OF THE TAX PROPERTY ARTICLE; AND
- (2) 5% OF ALL OTHER PUBLIC MONEY THAT THE CLERK RECEIVES, COLLECTS, AND PAYS OVER.
  - (D) BALTIMORE COUNTY.

THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR BALTIMORE COUNTY IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE:

- (1) 3% OF THE AMOUNT COLLECTED FROM THE TAX APPLICABLE TO INSTRUMENTS RECORDED WITH THE CLERK UNDER TITLE 12 OF THE TAX PROPERTY ARTICLE; AND
- (2) 5% OF ALL OTHER PUBLIC MONEY THAT THE CLERK RECEIVES, COLLECTS, AND PAYS OVER.
  - (E) CHARLES COUNTY.
- (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR CHARLES COUNTY SHALL:
