4-111. MANNER OF EXPRESSING ACCOUNTS.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL ACCOUNTS IN THE PUBLIC OFFICES OF THE STATE AND ALL PROCEEDINGS IN THE COURTS OF THE STATE.

(B) ACCOUNTS TO BE EXPRESSED IN DOLLARS AND CENTS.

ALL ACCOUNTS IN THE STATE SHALL BE EXPRESSED IN DOLLARS AND CENTS.

5-101.1. OATH.

IN ADDITION TO THE OATH SPECIFIED IN ARTICLE I, § 9 OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION, THE TREASURER SHALL TAKE AN OATH TO DISCHARGE THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE OF TREASURER FAITHFULLY, DILIGENTLY, AND HONESTLY.

8-205. SECRETARIES OF PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENTS; POWERS AND DUTIES.
