- 9-1211. STATE PROSECUTOR SELECTION AND DISABILITIES COMMISSION.
 - (A) ESTABLISHMENT.

THERE IS A STATE PROSECUTOR SELECTION AND DISABILITIES COMMISSION.

(B) MEMBERSHIP.

THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, EX OFFICIO, BUT WITH POWER TO VOTE, AND SIX INDIVIDUALS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) TWO INDIVIDUALS, ONLY ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE A LAWYER, SHALL BE SELECTED FROM AMONG TWO OR MORE NOMINEES WHO ARE NOT MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OR FULL-TIME STATE EMPLOYEES WHOSE NAMES ARE SUBMITTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE:
- (2) TWO INDIVIDUALS, ONLY ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE A LAWYER, SHALL BE SELECTED FROM AMONG TWO OR MORE NOMINEES WHO ARE NOT MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OR FULL-TIME STATE EMPLOYEES WHOSE NAMES ARE SUBMITTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES;
- (3) ONE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A LAWYER ADMITTED TO PRACTICE LAW IN THE STATE SHALL BE SELECTED FROM AMONG ONE OR MORE NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE MARYLAND STATE BAR ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED; AND
- (4) ONE INDIVIDUAL, WHO IS AN INCUMBENT STATE'S ATTORNEY AT THE TIME OF APPOINTMENT AND THROUGHOUT THE TERM AS A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION, SHALL BE SELECTED FROM AMONG ONE OR MORE NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MARYLAND STATE'S ATTORNEYS ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED, OR ITS SUCCESSOR.
