

(E) ADMINISTRATION.

(1) THE STATE TREASURER IS THE CUSTODIAN OF THE FUND.

(2) THE FUND SHALL BE INVESTED AND REINVESTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS STATE FUNDS.

(3) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DEPOSIT PAYMENTS RECEIVED FROM THE COMMISSIONER INTO THE FUND.

(F) STATUS AS TO GENERAL FUND.

(1) THE FUND IS A CONTINUING, NONLAPSING FUND AND IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE, AND MAY NOT BE DEEMED A PART OF THE GENERAL FUND.

(2) NO PART OF THE FUND MAY REVERT OR BE CREDITED TO:

(I) THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE; OR

(II) A SPECIAL FUND OF THE STATE.
