(A) IN GENERAL.

PART IV OF THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES TO EACH AUTHORIZED INSURER THAT WRITES PRIVATE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE IN THE STATE.

(B) APPLICATION TO MAIF.

EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE, PART IV OF THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO THE MARYLAND AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE FUND.

11–323. DATA ABOUT GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION OF PRIVATE PASSENGER PREMIUM.

(A) IN GENERAL.

ON OR BEFORE JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR, EACH INSURER AND THE MARYLAND AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE FUND SHALL FILE DATA ABOUT THE GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION OF PRIVATE PASSENGER PREMIUM WRITTEN BY IT IN THE STATE FOR THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR.

(B) REQUIRED FORM.

THE DATA REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:

- (1) BE FILED WITH THE COMMISSIONER IN THE FORM REQUIRED BY THE COMMISSIONER; AND
- (2) AT A MINIMUM, DETAIL THE AMOUNT OF PRIVATE PASSENGER PREMIUM WRITTEN BY THE INSURER AND THE MARYLAND AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE FUND IN THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR AND THE NUMBER OF POLICIES REPRESENTED BY THAT PREMIUM:
 - (I) IN THE STATE AS A WHOLE; AND
