- (IV) THAT THE APPLICANT HAS A SURPLUS, AS DEFINED IN § 14–117 OF THIS SUBTITLE, OF THE GREATER OF:
  - \$100,000; AND
- 2. AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THAT REQUIRED UNDER § 14–117 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

In item (2)(i) of this section, the phrase "in good faith" is substituted for the former archaic phrase "bona fide".

## 14-111. SCOPE OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY.

A CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AUTHORIZES A CORPORATION TO ISSUE CONTRACTS IN THE FORM FILED WITH THE COMMISSIONER TO PERSONS THAT BECOME SUBSCRIBERS TO THE PLAN.
