- (I) SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC;
- (II) MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED AN AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF THE STATE FOR ANY PURPOSE: AND
- (III) IS ENTITLED TO THE SAME RIGHTS, POWERS, AND PRIVILEGES AS THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.
  - (5) A CONSUMER MEMBER OF THE BOARD MAY NOT:
- (I) BE A LICENSEE OF OR OTHERWISE BE SUBJECT TO REGULATION BY THE COMMISSIONER;
  - (II) BE EMPLOYED BY OR HAVE A FINANCIAL INTEREST IN:
- 1. A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN OR ITS AFFILIATES OR SUBSIDIARIES; OR
- 2. A PERSON REGULATED UNDER THIS ARTICLE OR THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE; OR
- (III) WITHIN 1 YEAR BEFORE APPOINTMENT, HAVE BEEN EMPLOYED BY, HAD A FINANCIAL INTEREST IN, OR HAVE RECEIVED COMPENSATION FROM:
- 1. A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN OR ITS AFFILIATES OR SUBSIDIARIES; OR
- 2. A PERSON REGULATED UNDER THIS ARTICLE OR THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE.
  - (E) TERMS; QUALIFICATIONS; CHAIRMAN.
- (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A BOARD THAT HAS FEWER THAN THREE AUTHORIZED MEMBERS.
  - (2) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.
- (3) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF A BOARD SHALL BE STAGGERED OVER A 3-YEAR PERIOD AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD IN THE BYLAWS FILED AND APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER ON OR AFTER JUNE 1, 1993.
- (4) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (5) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
  - (6) A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE FOR MORE THAN:
    - (I) THREE FULL TERMS; OR
    - (II) A TOTAL OF MORE THAN 9 YEARS.
