WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER A SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF INFORMATION SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY, A DENTAL PLAN ORGANIZATION SHALL FILE NOTICE OF THE MODIFICATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER.

14-407. ISSUANCE OR DISAPPROVAL OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY.

(A) ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY.

IF THE COMMISSIONER IS SATISFIED THAT THE INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CONDUCTING THE AFFAIRS OF THE DENTAL PLAN ORGANIZATION ARE TRUSTWORTHY AND CAPABLE OF PROVIDING, ARRANGING FOR, OR ADMINISTERING THE SERVICES OFFERED BY THE DENTAL PLAN, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY.
