(b) Subject to the authority of the Board, jurisdiction over procurement is as follows:

(a) An individual who is not licensed to practice law in this State may represent a party in a proceeding before the Office if:

(2) the individual is representing:

(iv) a grievant at a proceeding conducted pursuant to [Article 41, § 4-102.1 of the Code] TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE CORRECTIONAL SERVICES ARTICLE concerning a grievance submitted to the Inmate Grievance Office, provided the representation is not otherwise restricted for reasons of security or expense pursuant to regulations, rules, directives, or policies adopted by the Division of Correction or Patuxent Institution;
