

**Article - Estates and Trusts**

2-109.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a judge of the court may not act as an attorney at law in a civil or criminal matter during a term of office.

(b) This section does not apply:

(1) In Harford County;

(2) In Montgomery County;

(3) In Baltimore City, to a judge of the Court while practicing law before any court of the State except an orphans' court; or

(4) In Prince George's [and], Calvert, AND HOWARD Counties, to a judge of the Court while practicing law in connection with a case that is:

(i) Outside the jurisdiction of orphans' court; and

(ii) Unrelated to the administration of an estate or guardianship.

**SECTION 2.** AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

**CHAPTER 116**

**(House Bill 1103)**

AN ACT concerning

**Wicomico County - Alcoholic Beverages - Fee and Fine Collection**

FOR the purpose of substituting in Wicomico County the director of finance for the Board of License Commissioners as the local collecting agent for alcoholic beverages fees and fines; clarifying that the director of finance in Wicomico County shall collect certain fees and fines; and generally relating to the collection of alcoholic beverages fees and fines in Wicomico County.
