SECTION 14. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if a person is placed by the Departments of Health and Mental Hygiene, Human Resources, or Juvenile Justice or the State Department of Education in a facility or program that becomes eligible for Medical Assistance Program (Medicaid) participation, and the Medical Assistance Program makes payment for such services, general funds equal to the general funds paid by the Medical Assistance Program to such a facility or program may be transferred from the previously mentioned departments to the Medical Assistance Program.
