Mr. President, Mr. Speaker,

Ladies and Gentlemen of the General Assembly

Pursuant to the authority conferred on me by Article III, Section 52, Subsection (5) of the Constitution of Maryland, and in accordance with the consent of the (State Senate) – (House of Delegates), duly granted, I hereby submit a supplement to House Bill 120 and/or Senate Bill 130 in the form of an amendment to the original budget for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2000.

Supplemental Budget No. 1 is only a technical amendment to the budget and does not affect the previously estimated funds available for budget operations.
