- (3) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY MAY ESTABLISH, REORGANIZE, OR CONSOLIDATE AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY IN THE DEPARTMENT AS NECESSARY TO FULFILL THE DUTIES ASSIGNED BY THE SECRETARY.
- (4) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (D) THE SECRETARY IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

Part II. Maryland Veterans Commission.

9-904.

- (a) In this Part II of this {subtitle} SUBTITLE, the following words have the meanings indicated.
 - (b) "Commission" means the Maryland Veterans Commission.
- (c) "Director" means the Director of the Maryland Veterans MARYLAND VETERANS Commission.

9-905.

There is a Maryland Veterans Commission IN THE DEPARTMENT. [9-906.

The Commission is an independent unit and, except by statute, may not be made a part of another unit of the State government.]
9-907.

- (a) (1) The Commission consists of the following 26 28 members:
- (i) as an ex officio member, the Chairman of the Maryland Veterans' Home Commission; and
 - (ii) 25 27 members appointed by the Governor.
 - (2) Of the 25 <u>27</u> appointed members:
- (i) 1 shall be appointed from each of the 8 congressional districts in the State;
 - (ii) 1 shall be appointed from the State at large; and

(III) 1 SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF A WOMEN VETERANS ORGANIZATION IN THE STATE; AND

- (iii) (IV) 1 shall be appointed from a list of individuals submitted to the Governor by each of the following organizations:
 - 1. the American Ex-Prisoners of War, Inc.;
