- (h) Subject to Title 7 of the State Finance and Procurement Article, the Commission may:
 - (1) accept gifts or grants;
- (2) unless otherwise provided, spend the principal and income of a gift or grant; and
- (3) invest all or part of the principal income in general obligations of the State or any other security.

Part III. Maryland Veterans' Home Commission.

In this Part III of this subtitle, "Home" means the home for veterans that the Maryland Veterans' Home Commission supervises.

- (a) The purposes of the Maryland Veterans' Home Commission are to operate and to manage in the State a home for veterans.
- (b) The General Assembly declares the purposes of the Maryland Veterans' Home Commission to be of general benefit to the veterans of the State.

This Part III of this subtitle does not limit any power or activity of:

- (1) a unit of the State government;
- (2) a political subdivision of the State; or
- (3) any person who is interested in veterans in the State.

There is a Maryland Veterans' Home Commission IN THE DEPARTMENT. 9-921.

- (a) The Veterans' Home Commission consists of the following 15 members:
- (1) 11 individuals appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate; and
 - (2) as ex officio members:
