REPOSITORY, the Commission shall issue a passenger-for-hire driver's license or a taxicab driver's license, as appropriate, to each applicant that meets the requirements of this title.

- (2) The passenger-for-hire driver's license and the taxicab driver's license shall be in the form that the Commission provides.
- [(c)] (D) The Commission may deny an applicant a license <u>OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE LICENSE</u> OF A <u>LICENSEE</u> if the applicant <u>OR LICENSEE</u> has been convicted of a crime that bears a direct relationship to the applicant's <u>OR LICENSEE'S</u> fitness to serve the public as a for-hire driver.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1999 is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
