**CHAPTER 207**

**(House Bill 74)**

AN ACT concerning

**State Personnel - Leave and Disciplinary Actions**

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Budget and Management to provide for administrative leave under certain conditions; repealing certain disciplinary actions that may be taken against certain employees; and generally relating to administrative leave and disciplinary actions.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

9-1104.

The Secretary may provide by regulation for leave with pay:

- (1) for jury service;
- (2) to attend employee organization events approved for this purpose by the Secretary;
- (3) for military training in a reserve unit of the armed forces or in the organized militia;
- (4) unless the employee is a party to the action or a paid witness, to appear in compliance with a subpoena:
  - (i) in court;
  - (ii) before a grand jury;
  - (iii) before an administrative unit; or
  - (iv) for a deposition; [and]
