

(4) A nonresident of any age must purchase either a nonresident basic hunting license or a nonresident 3-day hunting license to hunt in the State.

(5) The fees for hunting licenses are according to the following schedule:

(i) Resident, under the age of 16 years:

- 1. Basic hunting license\$ 6.50
- 2. Consolidated hunting license\$15.50

(ii) Resident, at least 16 years old and under the age of 65 years:

- 1. Basic hunting license.....\$15.50
- 2. Consolidated hunting license\$24.50

(iii) 1. Senior consolidated annual license for residents at least 65 years old\$ 1.25

2. Senior consolidated lifetime license for residents at least 65 years old\$12.50

(iv) Except as provided in subparagraph (v) of this paragraph, nonresident basic\$120.50

(v) Nonresident basic hunting license for residents of Delaware, Pennsylvania, Virginia, and West Virginia.....\$83.00 or a fee equal to the fee charged by the nonresident's home state for a similar basic hunting license, whichever fee is greater.

(vi) Complimentary license authorized to be issued under § 10-303 of this subtitleNo fee

(vii) Nonresident 3-day hunting license\$35.00

(6) The fees for individual hunting stamps are according to the following schedule:

(i) Deer stamp\$9.50

(ii) Bow and arrow stamp\$3.50

(iii) Black powder stamp\$3.50

(iv) Maryland migratory wild waterfowl stamp.....\$6.00

(v) Resident bonus deer stamp for each type of deer hunting season\$5.00

(vi) Nonresident bonus deer stamp for each type of deer hunting season\$25

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1999.
