- (2) AN OFFENSE UNDER ARTICLE 27, § 464B OF THE CODE;
- (3) (2) CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 27, § 35C(A)(2)(II) AND (6) OF THE CODE, OR AN OFFENSE UNDER THE LAWS OF ANOTHER STATE THAT WOULD CONSTITUTE CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 27, § 35C(A)(2)(II) AND (6) OF THE CODE IF COMMITTED IN THIS STATE; OR
- (4) (3) A CRIME OF VIOLENCE AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 27, § 643B OF THE CODE, OR AN OFFENSE UNDER THE LAWS OF ANOTHER STATE THAT WOULD BE A VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 27, § 643B OF THE CODE IF COMMITTED IN THIS STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act applies only to individuals applying for employment after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

(House Bill 1007)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 20 - Somerset County

9-116.

THE COUNTY ROADS BOARD MAY:

(1) SELL ALL OF THE COUNTYS RIGHT, TITLE, AND INTEREST IN AND TO THAT CERTAIN PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE DUBLIN ELECTION DISTRICT, SOMERSET COUNTY, MARYLAND, BEING ALL THAT PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE ROADBED OF COSTEN ROAD BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE
