- (6) IN THE CASE OF AN ASSIGNMENT REFLECTED IN AN INITIAL FINANCING STATEMENT UNDER § 9–514(A) OR AN AMENDMENT FILED UNDER § 9–514(B), THE RECORD DOES NOT PROVIDE A NAME AND MAILING ADDRESS FOR THE ASSIGNEE;
- (7) IN THE CASE OF A CONTINUATION STATEMENT, THE RECORD IS NOT FILED WITHIN THE SIX-MONTH PERIOD PRESCRIBED BY § 9-515(D); OR
- (8) THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY § 9-502(E) IS NOT PROVIDED OR RECORDATION TAX PAYABLE IS NOT TENDERED WITH THE FINANCING STATEMENT.
 - (C) FOR PURPOSES OF SUBSECTION (B):
- (1) A RECORD DOES NOT PROVIDE INFORMATION IF THE FILING OFFICE IS UNABLE TO READ OR DECIPHER THE INFORMATION; AND
- (2) A RECORD THAT DOES NOT INDICATE THAT IT IS AN AMENDMENT OR IDENTIFY AN INITIAL FINANCING STATEMENT TO WHICH IT RELATES, AS REQUIRED BY \S 9–512, \S 9–514, OR \S 9–518, IS AN INITIAL FINANCING STATEMENT.
- (D) A RECORD THAT IS COMMUNICATED TO THE FILING OFFICE WITH TENDER OF THE FILING FEE, BUT WHICH THE FILING OFFICE REFUSES TO ACCEPT FOR A REASON OTHER THAN ONE SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (B), IS EFFECTIVE AS A FILED RÉCORD EXCEPT AS AGAINST A PURCHASER OF THE COLLATERAL WHICH GIVES VALUE IN REASONABLE RELIANCE UPON THE ABSENCE OF THE RECORD FROM THE FILES.
- 9-517. EFFECT OF INDEXING ERRORS.

THE FAILURE OF THE FILING OFFICE TO INDEX A RECORD CORRECTLY DOES NOT AFFECT THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE FILED RECORD.

- 9-518. CLAIM CONCERNING INACCURATE OR WRONGFULLY FILED RECORD.
- (A) A PERSON MAY FILE IN THE FILING OFFICE A CORRECTION STATEMENT WITH RESPECT TO A RECORD INDEXED THERE UNDER THE PERSON'S NAME IF THE PERSON BELIEVES THAT THE RECORD IS INACCURATE OR WAS WRONGFULLY FILED.
 - (B) A CORRECTION STATEMENT MUST:
 - (1) IDENTIFY THE RECORD TO WHICH IT RELATES BY:
- (A) THE FILE NUMBER ASSIGNED TO THE INITIAL FINANCING STATEMENT TO WHICH THE RECORD RELATES; AND
- (B) IF THE CORRECTION STATEMENT RELATES TO A RECORD RECORDED IN A FILING OFFICE DESCRIBED IN § 9–501(A)(1), THE DATE AND TIME THAT THE INITIAL FINANCING STATEMENT WAS RECORDED AND THE INFORMATION SPECIFIED IN § 9–502(B);
 - (2) INDICATE THAT IT IS A CORRECTION STATEMENT, AND
- (3) PROVIDE THE BASIS FOR THE PERSON'S BELIEF THAT THE RECORD IS INACCURATE AND INDICATE THE MANNER IN WHICH THE PERSON BELIEVES THE
