CHAPTER 286

(House Bill 1075)

AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources - Fishing Guide *and Tidal Fish* Licenses

FOR the purpose of requiring a person to obtain a license from the Department of Natural Resources before providing services as a freshwater fishing guide under certain circumstances; requiring a certain applicant to possess certain fishing licenses and stamps; requiring a certain application or renewal form and a certain fee for a certain freshwater fishing guide permit; ~~requiring the Department to determine the waters in which a person may guide for certain fish; restricting a person with a certain freshwater fishing guide license to guide only in tidal waters designated by the Department;~~ providing for the issuance of a certain license subject to certain conditions; altering the circumstances under which a person may transfer a tidal fish license or authorization to certain persons; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations; authorizing the Department to suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue a certain license under certain circumstances; making stylistic changes; providing for the termination of a certain portion of this Act; providing for the application of certain provisions of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to fishing guide licenses.
