- (2) A-MEMBER OF THE BOARD MAY ISSUE SUBPOENAS FOR THE BOARD, FOR A NEUTRAL MEMBER OF A FACT-FINDING PANEL, OR FOR ANY PARTY TO BOARD PROCEEDINGS OR FACT-FINDING PROCEEDINGS, TO COMPEL THE ATTENDANCE AND TESTIMONY OF WITNESSES OR TO COMPEL THE PRODUCTION FOR EXAMINATION OF ANY DOCUMENTS.
- (B) IF-A PERSON FAILS TO COMPLY WITH A SUBPOENA OR REFUSES TO BE SWORN OR TO TESTIFY THEN, ON COMPLAINT OF A MEMBER OF THE BOARD, THE, CIRCUIT COURT MAY ORDER THE PERSON TO COMPLY WITH THE SUBPOENA, TO BE SWORN, OR TO TESTIFY.
