- (i) the services of a tree expert, as defined under \S 5–415(c) of the Natural Resources Article; or
 - (ii) practices and services generally provided by:
 - 1. an arboriculturist;
 - 2. a gardener:
 - 3. a horticulturist:
 - 4. a landscape contractor;
 - 5. 'a landscape gardener;
 - 6. a nurseryman; or
 - 7. an orchardist.
- (f) "Responsible charge" means direct control and personal direction of the practice of forestry that requires initiative, professional skill, and independent judgment.]

7-308.

- (a) Unless a license is renewed for a 2-year term as provided in this section, the license expires on the first September 30 that comes:
 - (1) after the effective date of the license; and
 - (2) in an even-numbered year.
- (b) At least 30 days before a license expires, the Board shall mail to the licensee, at the last known address of the licensee:
 - (1) a renewal application form; and
 - (2) a notice that states:
 - (i) the date on which the current license expires;
- (ii) the date by which the Board must receive the renewal application for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and
 - (iii) the amount of the renewal fee.
- (c) (1) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:
 - (i) otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
- (ii) except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, pays to the Board a renewal fee of \$100; and
- $\ensuremath{\mbox{(iii)}}$ submits to the Board a renewal application on the form that the Board provides.
