~~(B) (1) A PERSON WHO OPERATES AN AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR FACILITY SHALL KEEP ACCURATE AND COMPLETE RECORDS AT THE LOCATION WHERE MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIRS ARE CONDUCTED OF:~~

~~(I) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE OWNER OF EACH MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIRED OR STORED AT THE AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR FACILITY;~~

~~(II) THE DATE A MOTOR VEHICLE WAS LEFT AT THE AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR FACILITY;~~

~~(III) THE YEAR, MODEL, AND VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF THE VEHICLE; AND~~

~~(IV) FOR ANY PARTS OF MOTOR VEHICLES AT THE AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR FACILITY, PROOF OF OWNERSHIP OR PROOF OF THE RIGHT OF POSSESSION.~~

~~(2) A PERSON WHO OPERATES A VEHICLE STORAGE FACILITY SHALL KEEP ACCURATE AND COMPLETE RECORDS AT THE LOCATION WHERE VEHICLES ARE STORED OF:~~

~~(I) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE INDIVIDUAL WHO REQUESTED STORAGE OF EACH VEHICLE;~~

~~(II) THE DATE THAT EACH VEHICLE WAS BROUGHT INTO THE VEHICLE STORAGE FACILITY;~~

~~(III) THE YEAR, MODEL, AND, IF AVAILABLE, THE VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF EACH VEHICLE; AND~~

~~(C) THE RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL BE KEPT FOR AT LEAST 3 YEARS AFTER THE TRANSACTION TO WHICH THE RECORD APPLIES.~~

~~(D) DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS, RECORDS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION AND PARTS AND VEHICLES FOR WHICH RECORDS ARE REQUIRED SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION BY THE ADMINISTRATION OR BY A POLICE OFFICER ON ANY PREMISES OWNED OR OPERATED BY AN AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR FACILITY OR VEHICLE STORAGE FACILITY.~~
