- (B) THE LOCAL TEAM <u>MEMBERSHIP</u> SHALL BE <u>COMPOSED OF AT LEAST 18</u> <u>MEMBERS, INCLUDING</u> <u>DRAWN FROM THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS</u>, ORGANIZATIONS, AGENCIES, AND AREAS OF EXPERTISE, WHEN AVAILABLE:
 - (1) THE COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER:
 - (2) THE COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER;
 - (3) THE DIRECTOR OF THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES:
 - (4) (3) THE STATE'S ATTORNEY;
 - (5) (4) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS;
- $\frac{(6)}{(5)}$ A STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER;
- (7) (6) THE DIRECTOR OF THE COUNTY SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAM:
- (8) (7) THE CHIEF ATTORNEY WHO REPRESENTS THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES IN CHILD WELFARE PROCEEDINGS;
- $\frac{(9)}{(8)}$ The regional representative of the child care administration;
- (10) (9) THE DIRECTOR OF THE COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH AGENCY OR CORE SERVICE AGENCY;
- (11) (10) A PEDIATRICIAN WITH EXPERIENCE IN DIAGNOSING AND TREATING INJURIES AND CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT, APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER;
- (12) (11) A PSYCHIATRIST OR PSYCHOLOGIST WITH EXPERIENCE IN CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT OR CHILD INJURY, APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH AGENCY OR CORE SERVICE AGENCY: AND
- (12) A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC WITH INTEREST OR EXPERTISE IN THE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT OF CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT, APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER; AND
- (13) ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL NECESSARY TO THE WORK OF THE LOCAL TEAM, RECOMMENDED BY THE LOCAL TEAM AND APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER.
- (C) THE MEMBERS DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(1) THROUGH (10) (9) OF THIS SECTION MAY DESIGNATE REPRESENTATIVES FROM THEIR DEPARTMENTS OR OFFICES TO REPRESENT THEM ON THE LOCAL TEAM.
- (D) EACH PUBLIC AGENCY REPRESENTED ON THE LOCAL TEAM SHALL PROVIDE SUFFICIENT STAFF SUPPORT TO COMPLETE THE LOCAL TEAM'S RESPONSIBILITIES.
