(e) Any person who fails to pay the excise tax as required in this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.

(a) For collecting and remitting the tax, a licensed dealer who, on behalf of the Administration, collects the excise tax imposed by this part [for any Class A (passenger) vehicle, Class D (motorcycle) vehicle, Class G (trailer) travel trailer or camping trailer, or Class M (multipurpose) vehicle,] may keep THE LESSER OF \$24 PER VEHICLE OR 1.2 percent of the gross excise tax [he] THE DEALER collects [for these vehicles] UP TO \$24 PER VEHICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1999.
