- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "LICENSED PERSONNEL" MEANS:
- (1) A REGISTERED NURSE WHO IS LICENSED TO PRACTICE IN THE STATE: OR
 - (2) A PRACTICAL NURSE WHO IS LICENSED TO PRACTICE IN THE STATE.
- (B) A NURSING FACILITY SHALL EMPLOY STAFF SUFFICIENT IN NUMBER AND QUALIFICATIONS TO MEET THE SCHEDULED AND UNSCHEDULED NURSING CARE NEEDS OF THE RESIDENTS.
- (C) TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A NURSING FACILITY SHALL:
- (1) ESTABLISH AND EMPLOY REGISTERED NURSES WHO ARE LICENSED TO PRACTICE IN THE STATE FOR THE FOLLOWING POSITIONS:
