AN ACT concerning

Maryland Home Improvement Commission - Temporary Licenses

FOR the purpose of repealing the authority of the Maryland Home Improvement Commission to issue certain temporary licenses; and generally relating to licensing by the Commission.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Regulation

[8-304.

- (a) In accordance with regulations adopted by the Commission, the executive director may issue a temporary license to an applicant who submits to the Commission:
 - (1) a proper application for a license; and
 - (2) each required fee.
- (b) (1) A temporary contractor license authorizes the holder to act as a contractor or subcontractor and to sell a home improvement.
- (2) A temporary subcontractor license authorizes the holder to act as a subcontractor.
- ${\bf (3)} \quad \hbox{$A$ temporary salesperson license authorizes the holder to sell a home improvement.}$
 - (c) A temporary license:
- (1) may be terminated by the executive director before the Commission issues or denies a license to the applicant; and
- (2) expires when the Commission issues or denies a license to the applicant.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1999.
