Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

- (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of its interest:
- (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.
- (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1999.

CHAPTER 387

(Senate Bill 786)

AN ACT concerning

Security Systems Technicians - Registration Requirements and Procedures

FOR the purpose of repealing a requirement that an applicant seeking to register as a security systems technician provide certain recommendations; allowing a person seeking to renew a registration as a security systems technician to submit payment for certain criminal records check costs to a licensed security systems agency for forwarding to the Secretary of the State Police; providing that the Secretary of the State Police may refuse to issue a temporary registration as a security systems technician to an individual if the issuance would result in a potential threat to public safety; providing that an individual who obtains a temporary registration as a security systems technician shall receive a certain form of identification from the Secretary of the State Police; authorizing the Secretary of the State Police to create an advisory panel to conduct certain hearings on behalf of the Secretary; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the registration requirements and procedures for security systems technicians.
